- All Zakaat are strictly applied in accordance with Shariah guidelines and utilized before start of next Ramadan.
- We receive non-Zakaat general donations for our mission.

Transparency

- Administrative expenses are borne by trustees, ensuring every rupee of your donations is utilized for education.
- Under **Own a Student Program** donors are provided with yearly student performance report and funds utilization summary.
- Trustees are not entitled to any remuneration. ILM is managed by a team of reputable professionals within Pakistan and abroad. More than **Rs.5 million** of donations contributed by only Trustees and Management members.
